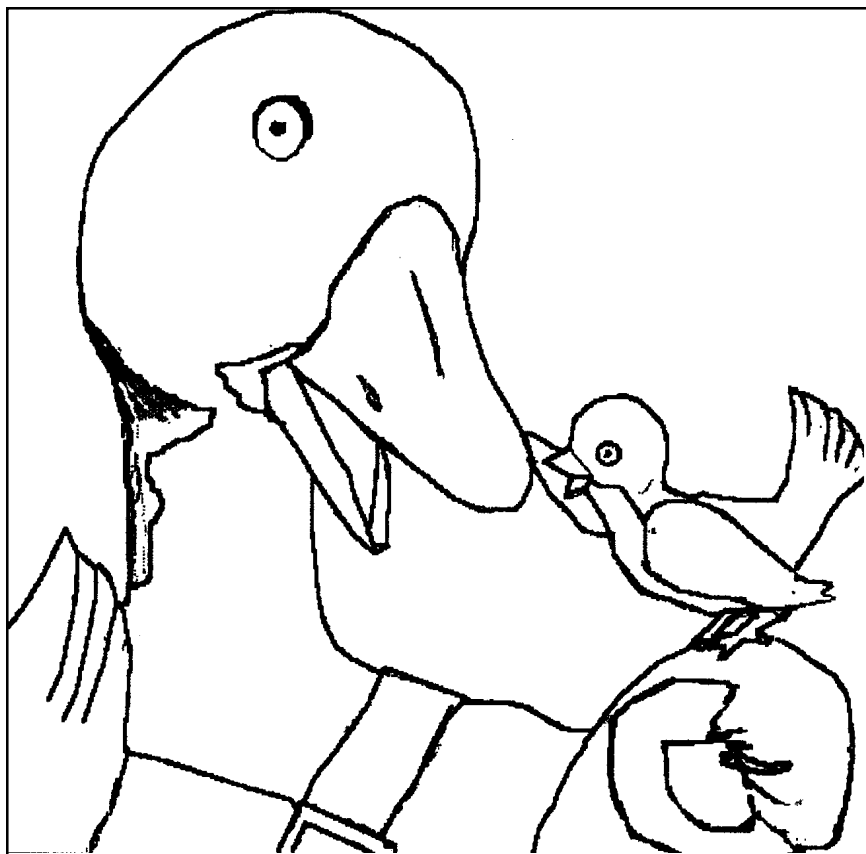
...the first thing anyone noticed about this particular goose was his Wonderful Attitude!



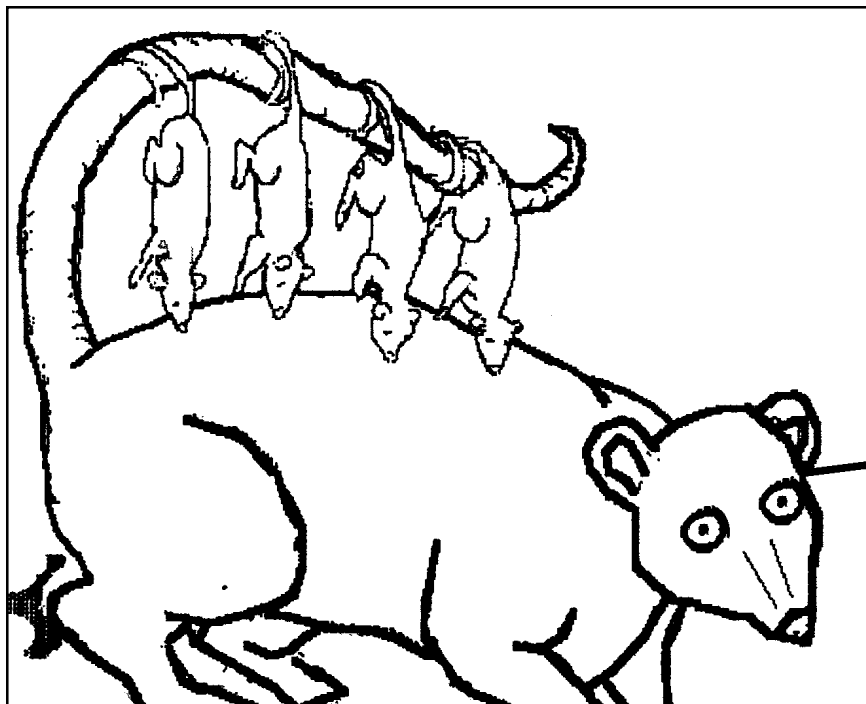
In fact, Cripple Goose tended his own parcel of land!



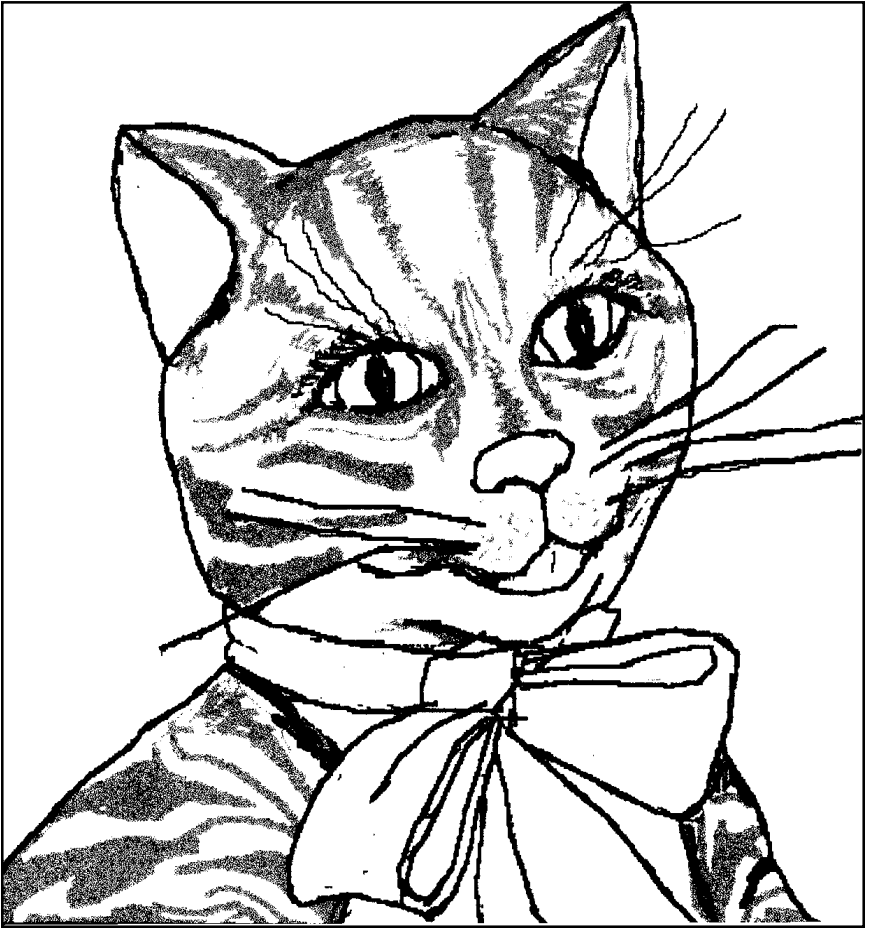
Each of the nine fluffy ducklings looked pleadingly to their mama for permission! They would never, ever, go anywhere without her permission!



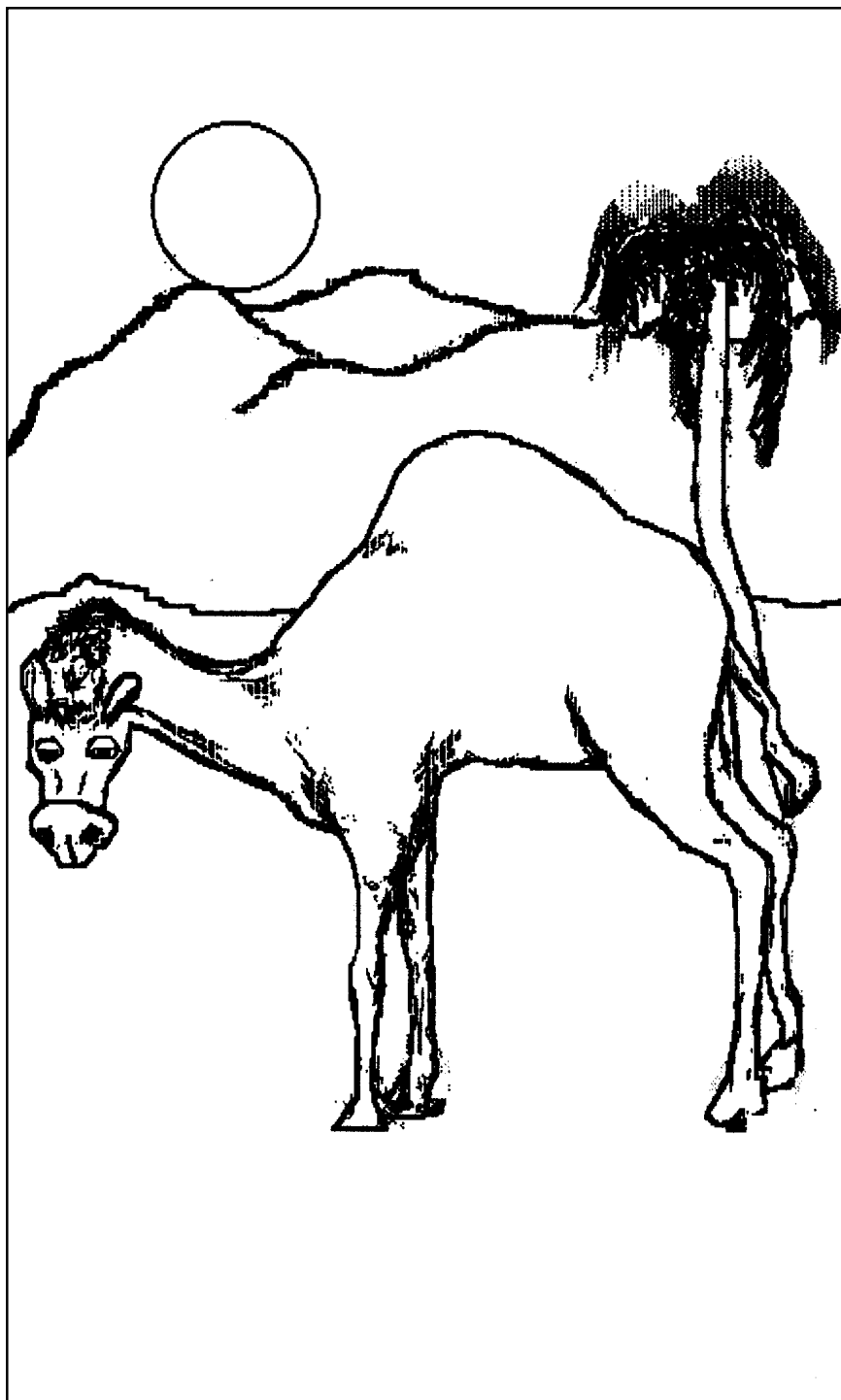
OK... Now I'm ready.

"Moo-o-o"..."

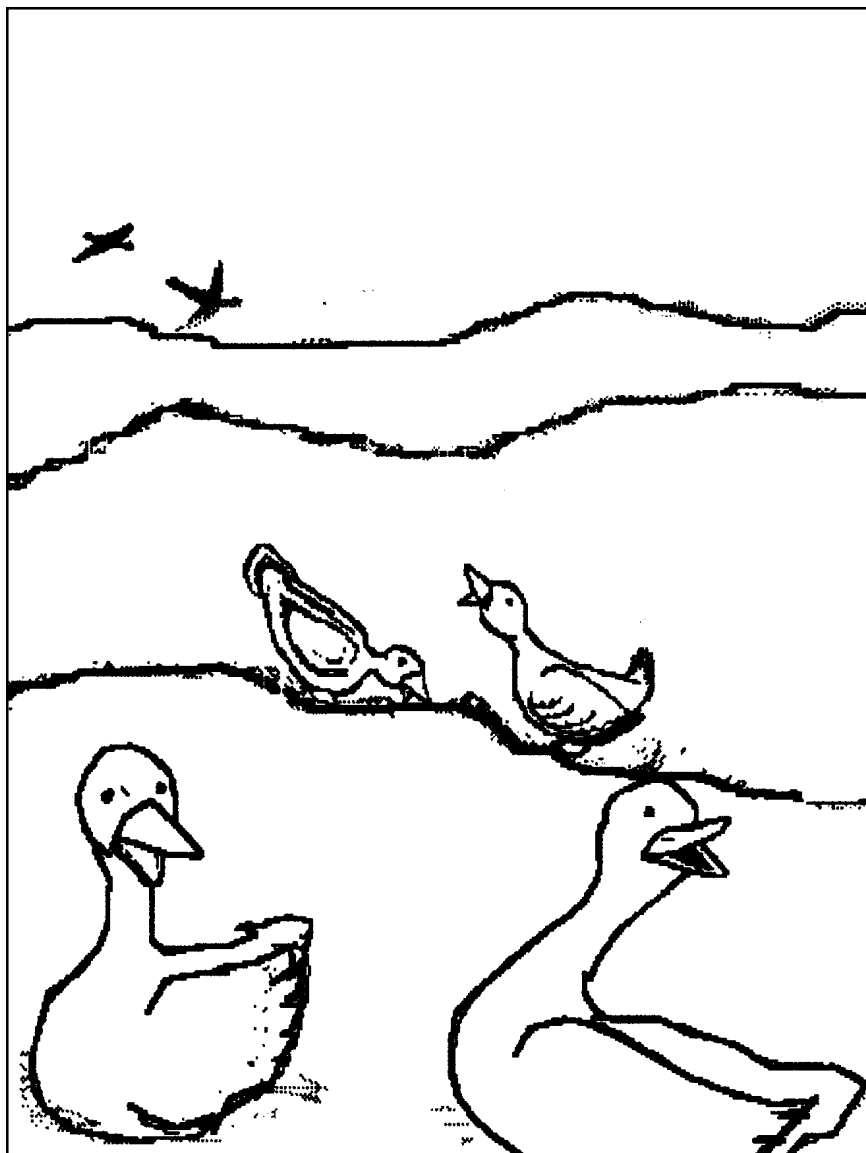


*It's all part of God's wonderful
plan that Kittycats say "Meow",*

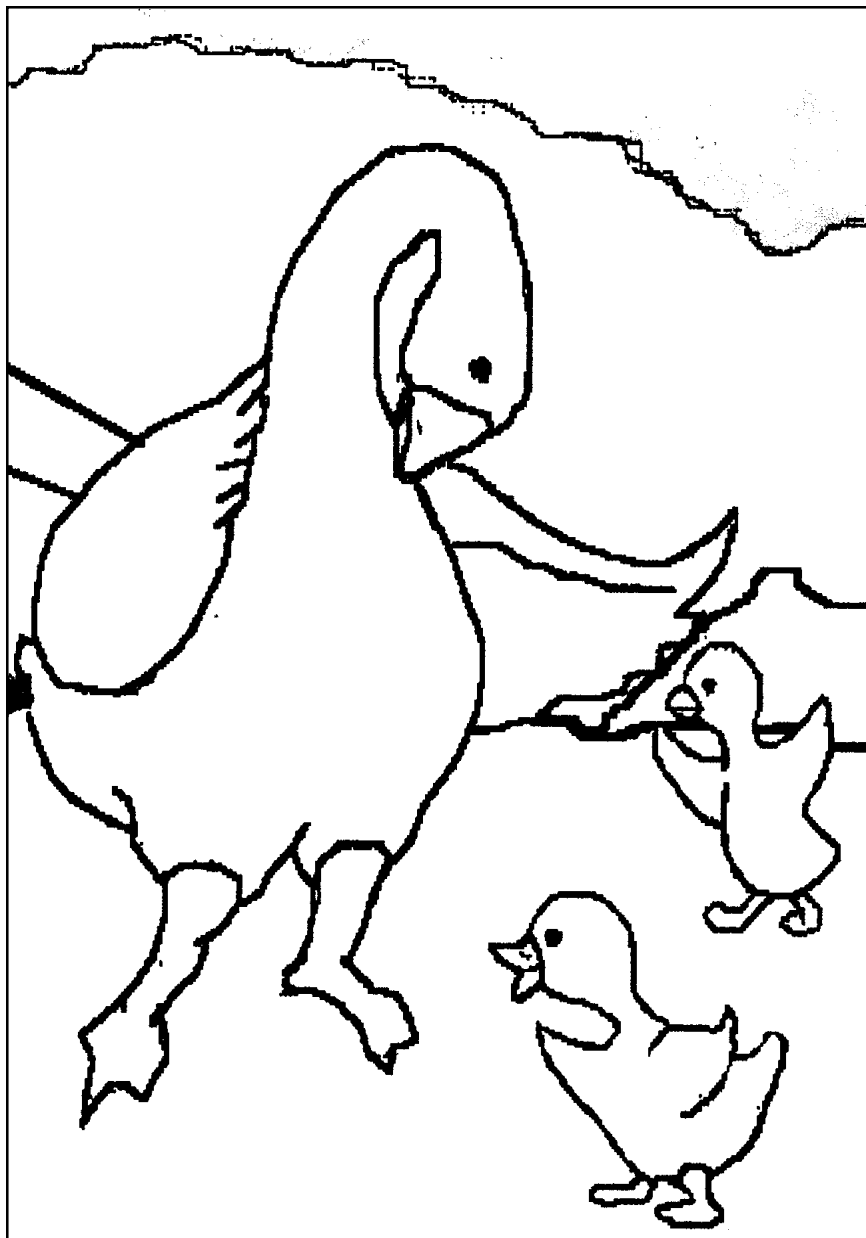


*And the funny-looking Camel

oughta,*

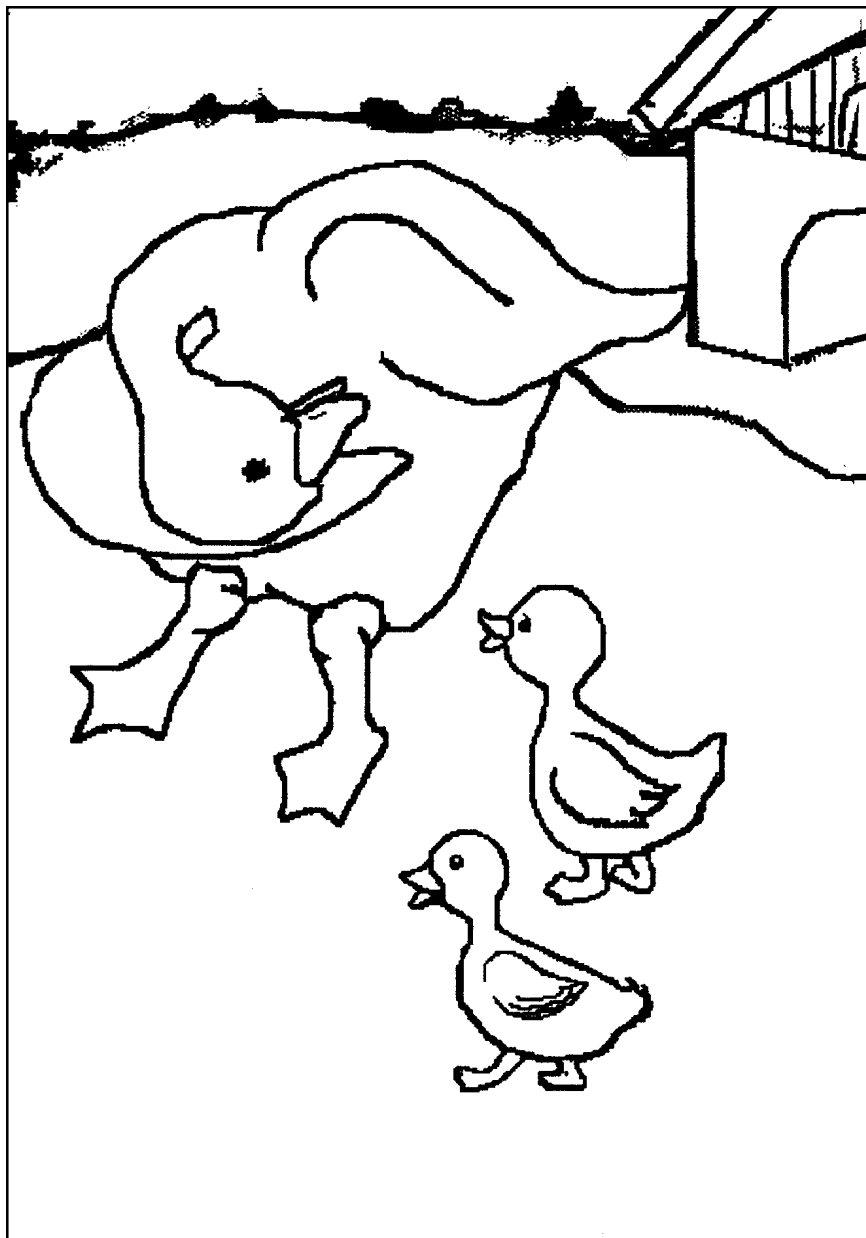




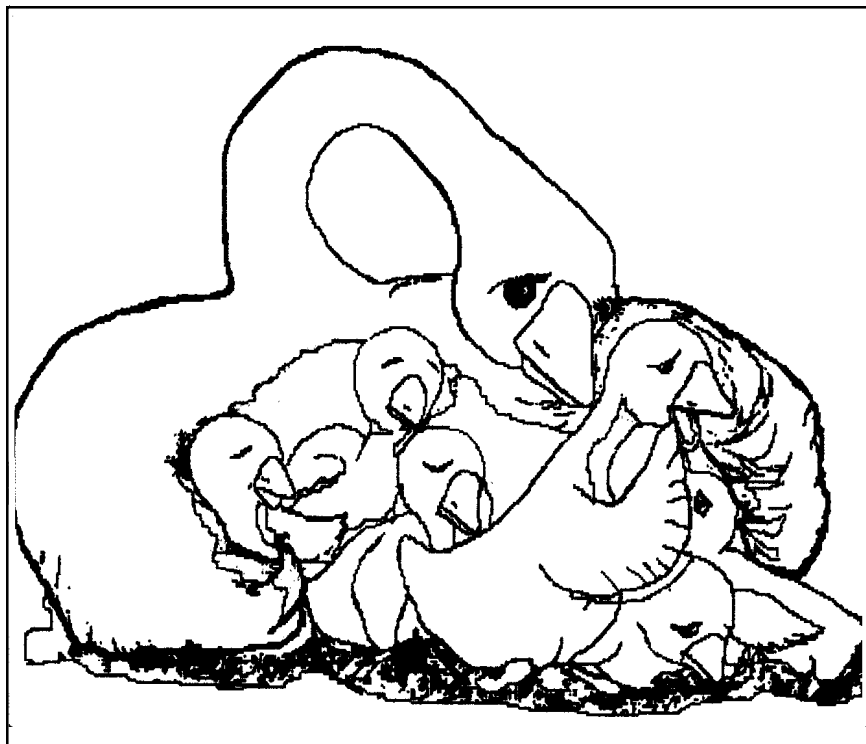
*And a quack-quack here, and a

might be call Red Goose.



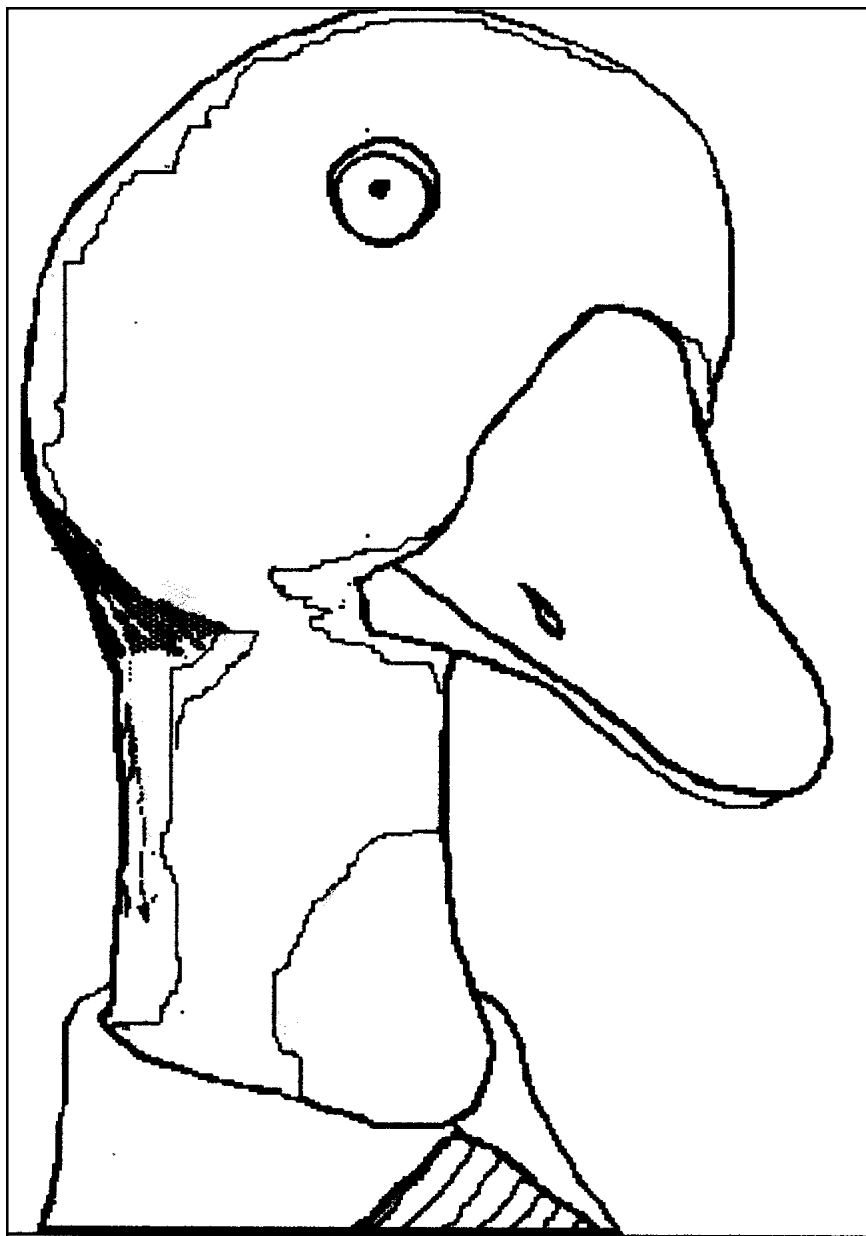
If I were blue I could perhaps be
